

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT YOUR Honed Absolute Black Granite

Absolute Black usually comes in a polished finish. If a honed finish is desired, please be aware of the following:

- Finish may be hazy or inconsistent due to variation in stone and any resin variance on the surface.
- The process of honing a natural stone opens the porosity in the stone. When honing Absolute Black Granite, this porosity may lead to finger printing and water spots; these prints and spots take place when oils from human touch are transferred to the material. These oils transfer on any stone, but are much more apparent in a honed solid black surface. Water spotting may occur when placing a glass on the surface, and the condensation on the side of the cup drips on to the stone. These spots will usually dry out, but will cause a variation in surface appearance for days or weeks.
- Cooking oils will also spot honed Absolute Black Granite.

CR Home cannot be held responsible for small inconsistencies in honed Absolute Black Granite after fabrication. CR Home recommends the customer view, approve, and sign off on honed Absolute Black Granite slabs prior to fabrication. These inconsistencies do not imply any weakness or lower performance.

CR Home is not responsible for honed Absolute Black Granite which may vary from samples provided.
